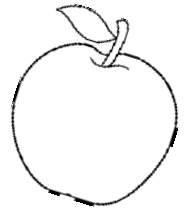


First Grade News

September



Curriculum Updates

We are so excited to be back at school! We are going to have a lot of fun learning about each other and about First Grade! We are going to work very hard this first month of school!

Reading:

First graders will read in small groups, at their own level and progress at their own pace. Students will differentiate between fiction and non-fiction texts by identifying the characteristics of each. The students will work on retelling how characters feelings can change at the beginning, middle and end of stories.

Writing:

First Graders will begin using drawings and sentences to retell an event for their narrative writing pieces using beginning, middle and end.

Students will revise, edit, and publish their writing.

Math:

First graders are building their number sense. The students will be using a 120's chart to locate missing numbers, and find one more/one less than a given number. We will create models of numbers to compare numbers and we will use the symbols for greater than, less than and equal to ($>$, $<$, $=$).

Science:

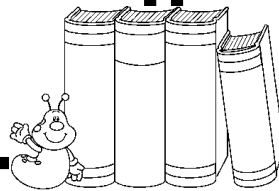
First Graders will be learning about the sun and the moon. The students will be learning about the patterns that are taking place.
